Atlantic Fabrics Creative Class Terms & Conditions

- Payment in full is required upon registration in order to secure your space.
- Classes require a minimum of 4-6 students. Maximum varies based on the class.
- Class fees do not include HST, fabric and supplies unless otherwise noted.
- Upon registration you will receive a supply list outlining what you require for class.
- Sewing classes require that you bring your own sewing machine and/or serger (in good working order) and a basic sewing kit. Basic Sewing Kit consists of needles (hand and machine), thread, seam ripper, scissors, straight pins, pencil/pen and paper. Additional supplies required, including fabrics, will be stated on your list.
- Basic sewing Kits are available for purchase. Sewing machines are available to rent for \$7 per session. Bobbin and needle included. Thread sold separately.
- Classroom is open 15 minutes before class – Please arrive early to get organized.
- Atlantic Fabrics Creative Classes are SCENT FREE due to severe allergic reactions. We ask that you please refrain from wearing perfumes and cosmetic scents, as well as using spray adhesives and other strongly scented items in class.

Class Cancellation Policy:

Should Atlantic Fabrics cancel the class due to insufficient registration numbers, students will receive one (1) week advanced notice and full refund on class. Refunds will only be issued within 30 days of the original class start date.

We suggest waiting for confirmation that the class has sufficient registrations to go ahead before purchasing fabrics and supplies, as some items may be non-refundable
